
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Native American Leather & Bead Crafting

This is a book that will give someone who has already had some experience with crafts and needlework ideas and methods to make some items of Native American projects. There are 36 projects in herewith rudimentary directions and good photographs of the finished item. They range from jewelry, pouches, shirts, moccasins to beaded bowls.We did complete two of the beaded bowls and enjoyed making them and the finished bowl looked very nice.Not all the beads used are described or pictured in the beginning which shows techniques and working with leather. The illustrations are not well detailed which is the main reason I would say that you need to have some needlework technique before starting to use this book as your guide. Patterns need enlargement but

the activities are not involved or complicated themselves. This would be an interesting book for those who wish to try some different designs and items to make.

Beautifully illustrated, with information about native tribes, however, I didn't purchase the book for information about native American tribes, I purchased the book to learn how to craft with beads and leather.
