

This book begins with a nice background on issues surrounding spatial - projections, ellipsoid, spheroid and geoid concepts that are necessary to move on and use the technology correctly. It's

about the perfect level of depth of explanation without delaying getting to SQL Server 2012 implementation. The book then moves into data types. By chapter 4 you're into practical application along with continued explanation. Expect a dense, lengthy read. The graphics are used appropriately - sparingly and to augment the topics being explained. The examples and exercises are helpful and rich. The breadth of application that this book covers is really impressive. It's a great read for developers and BI folks. Route finding, clustering analysis, shapefiles, spatial indexing, custom assemblies, Bing Maps API, SSRS. The writing style brings this all to you clearly and concisely, which makes it a pleasure to get through so much content and ensures that you have a better chance of retaining it all. Very impressive book and highly recommended to anyone from novice to experienced spatial analyst/developer.

I read Alastair's first book on this topic Beginning Spatial with SQL Server 2008 several times and was really looking forward to reading this new book. It didn't disappoint. Lots of great information contained in here which you will be hard pressed to find anywhere else. A great investment for anyone interested in working with Geography or Geometry types in SQL.

Good introduction to SQL Server spatial data, but hardly "pro". Code examples consisted of hooking Microsoft web APIs. Very little instruction in integrating geo data into sprocs and just a little in the nuances geo adds to your query tuning. I am delving into geographically aware large datasets and this book, much like geo in SQL Server, is good for building a foundation, but doesn't put the rubber on the road for real-world applications.

This book is great. The author describes topics in clear and understandable fashion. This book is very good for GIS/Computer Science practitioners (who are interested in spatial databases). Management of spatial data in RDBMS is an advanced topic in DBMS and this book greatly explains many important topics on spatial databases (in MS SQL Server 2012 which itself is one of the best commercial DBMSs).
