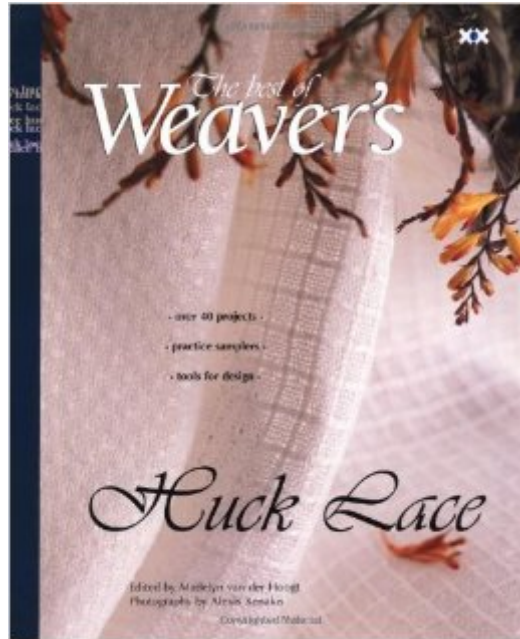

I love this book! A great addition to my weaving library. Some of the projects look dated, but the Huck weave structure is very well explained, with lots of variations and most projects in the book are timeless. The majority of the projects are for 8 shafts or more.

This is the only book out there on this weave structure, making it a vital addition to your library, especially if you do a lot of lace weaves. Written for the advanced weaver, it shows a wide variety of drafts for huck, and shows you how to make your own. Good stuff!
